This is a tough decision. I have the Xsi (Canon 450D). I immediately wanted more zoom range. You will miss the range your Powershot has compared to the kit lens.

Before my daughter 's graduation, I had a little windfall profit, and I found a 18-200 OS Quantaray on craigslist. That is not the best lens, but I don't see it being worse than my kit lens, and the zoom range is WONDERFUL! My next lens will be the 50mm 1.8.
