

3 Great Advantages of Using Prepaid Phone Cards

The first advantage of prepaid calling cards is that they can be bought anywhere - at the gas station, the local convenience store or the internet. It comes in varied denominations of 5, 10, 20, 25, 50 dollars, with increasing amount of minutes. There are no monstrous taxes on these cards like the cellular phone and landline services. The prepaid phones are an advantage because they are safe to carry around just like the credit or debit cards. The prepaid phone cards carry credit on them which we have paid for when we buy them. Once these cards are bought the credit on the can be used up until the expiry date which is generally 90 days.

Another advantage of carrying the calling cards is that they can be used from anywhere - a cell phone or a landline - even when both these options do not have international calling or long distance calling facilities. You could use it from the shopping mall or your home, from your cell or the Wi-Fi smart phones over the Internet! They are very easy to use - after you have chosen the right calling card, one only needs to scratch the strip hiding the PIN. Dial the access number, give the PIN number and enter the country, region and telephone numbers to get through to anyone around the world. Some companies even refund the money when the calling cards are surrendered.

It is an economic option for business people who make international calls and the businesses who send their people around the globe. Imagine the telephone bills of the people who have to make lengthy international calls every day and the relief they will feel at the use of the prepaid calling cards which will slash their bills by 85%. The calls can be left untraced or an itemized statement can be asked of the provider company. Instead of look or changes all the time - the [Pakistan phone cards](#) can be used as another option of freeing oneself of carrying money around. The lesser money on you the lesser the losses - if one gets mugged. So carrying money on the cell phone, credit card or debit card to pay for other things; an international calling card to make calls home is an intelligent choice.

Among the prepaid phone cards too there are options of using the local access number and the international toll free numbers. Here the international access is given by a local number - the cost of which is borne by the caller (the charge per minute plus the local call rates) but it is cheaper than the tariff of the toll free numbers. This way one can avoid astronomical phone bills at the end of the month. The calling cards monitor the usage of minutes giving you an idea of the amount of credit left and to control it. It is an excellent option for students living away from home and overseas to remain in touch with friends and family. Also using local service providers will give you more minutes that the toll free numbers.
