But you might also want to consider one of the local vineyards, or even just a simple hill overlooking the incredible beauty of the countryside. There are also any number of picturesque settings along the rivers that flow through the region. You want to again balance the cost and logistics considerations when choosing the location of the ceremony. A setting out in the country might be perfect in one respect, but might also require additional travel expense to get to from the nearest city with hotels.

Next, **think about putting together a little travel guide** for your guests. They will be coming a long way for your event, and certainly, the wedding will be the focus of their travels. But many will also want to get out and sample some of the incredible offerings of the region.
