Expertly Engaging in Trivia Board Games

A person who loves to read books would find it interesting and amusing to play trivia board games. It is all based upon the questions posed and follows no particular order. Questions are compiled which are taken from different fields of study and areas of interest. The pioneering trivial board game innovated by Scott Abbott and Chris Haney, the Trivial Pursuit, was launched 1981 but was really set up in 1975. The game can be played by up to 24 players which includes a board, question cards, playing pieces with small plastic wedges to fit into them, and a box. Categories of six have representing colors which are as follows: orange for Sports and Leisure, green for Science and Nature, yellow for History, blue for Geography, pink for Entertainment, and brown for Art and Literature. The player is considered winner when first to reach back the hexagonal hub. Other Editions of the game are innovated by Warner Brothers Edition, Trivial Pursuit Junior, Trivial Pursuit Genus IV, V, and VI.

The Strategic Game of Chess

Chess is among the board games that can only be played by two people. The objective of the game is to eliminate the opponent's king piece where it has no chance of moving or subduing an enemy piece without getting eliminated. The game is set in a checked game board eight squares horizontal and eight squares vertical summing up a total of 64 squares. Every player has 16 pieces for him to play the game which comprise of two rooks, eight pawns, two knights, one king, two bishops, and one queen. Both players take turns in moving a piece in accordance with the game rules but not during castling where two pieces are allowed to move. Usually the player with the light colored pieces go first and the piece can land on an empty square or one which is occupied by an opponents piece but will be captured and removed from the game. The rules and regulations of the game chess is maintained by the World Chess Federation.

The Stimulating Monopoly Board Game

The most commercially successful among board games is Monopoly which has been played by over 500 million people in the United States and worldwide. Charles Darrow in 1935 patented the game and having Mr. Monopoly or Rich Uncle Penny bags as the mascot. The theme of the game is real estate and players win by becoming the wealthiest among the other players through building, buying and selling out properties like lots, hotels and houses as well as collecting rents and bankrupting the opponents. The game consists of 2-8 players and includes \$15,140.00 worth of money, 22 property title deed cards, 16 community chest cards, 16 chance cards, 32 houses, 12 hotels, 11 Monopoly tokens, 2 dice, and a game board. With every roll of the dice, each player moves accordingly on the game board. Let your luck turn the game on you and wipe out your opponents as early as possible before they do otherwise.

Aiding in Cooperative Board Games

Cooperative board games enable players to work for a certain objective that could either be against another set of players or against the game. These games emphasizes on team cooperation, which means winning or losing as a team, rather than individual competition. To make it more challenging, events in the game do not come in succession but at random as the game goes on. The Arkham The Scotland Yard, released in the 1980s, is a good example of these games. Players that mimic as detectives team up to look for another player also mimicking as a criminal and everything is set to the streets of London. Arkham Horror, another game in the 1980s is about players who act as investigators who works together to protect H. P. Lovecraft's Massachusetts town of Arkham against aliens and monsters to enter through the gates and eventually close these portals. Choices of other cooperative board games are Pandemic, Lord of the Rings, and Shadow Over Camelot.
