If you are looking for more than snorkeling from shore, look into taking a trip on the "Scuba Cat" tour boat for a half day snorkel adventure.

While Catalina Island is most well known for its beautiful, clean, and clear waters, it is also a great place to hike or bike. In the inner parts of the island, you will find an assortment of rolling hills and secluded coves, bald eagles, catalina fox, and even buffalo. Hiking permits are required, but they are available free at the Conservancy Office, located at 125 Clarissa Ave. As for biking, you must purchase a \$20 permit that is valid for 2-days; this small fee is well worth the investment.

In short, Catalina Island is a popular vacation destination, but it is still a relatively well-kept secret. By timing your trip right, you will gain access to some of the best snorkeling tours in on the USA West Coast.
